

# Belmont Shooting Complex Upgrade Project


## Project update Issue 2 – June 2016

### Construction works about to commence

Construction of permanent upgrades at the Belmont Shooting Complex has been awarded to Broad Construction Services and works are scheduled to commence on site from July 2016.

Construction activity will initially focus on upgrading the existing Queensland Target Sports pistol and rifle ranges that were used for the 1982 Commonwealth Games. These works require temporary closure of the Queensland Target Sports facility during construction from late June 2016 to early 2017. During this time the Queensland Target Sports operations will temporarily relocate to other existing pistol ranges within the complex.

Minor upgrades to the Duncan Full Bore Rifle Range includes some landscaping works to the rear area of the 1000 yard firing line and minor upgrades to the adjoining amenities blocks. The project team will coordinate the timing of these works to minimise any impact on use of the range. The final details of the construction of temporary facilities for hosting Commonwealth Games events will be available later in the year.

### Upgrade to culverts

The project will now incorporate important upgrade works to the culverts at the main entry into the venue. These upgrades are designed to overcome access issues caused by regular flooding of the existing culverts during wet weather events. The project team is pleased to be able to incorporate this additional scope into the overall works which will have long-term benefits for the entire complex.

The timing for the works to the culverts is yet to be confirmed and further information will be provided prior to these works commencing.

### Access changes during construction

Construction works will be carefully staged to allow site-users sufficient access to surrounding ranges throughout the construction phase.

From time-to-time there may be access changes to areas within the complex to allow for the works to occur. The Queensland Rifle Association will issue notices to user groups prior to any significant access changes and redirection signage will be placed around the complex as appropriate.

### Project timeframes

Construction works from mid-2016 to early 2017.
