

50m PISTOL – EST

Before the competition

- Your eye protection
- Your hearing protection
- Stopwatch
- Targets set correctly
- Range Incident Forms
- (for competition) check
 - Shooters in the correct bays
 - Pistols and other equipment approved
 - Shooters wearing Start numbers if provided

Preparation and competition:

Check the range is clear of personnel, call....

“ATHLETES TO THE LINE”

- Competitors to be allowed *15 minutes to set up their equipment.
- Dry firing and aiming exercises are permitted. Range Officer checks must be completed during this time.

(Note: all details must be allowed the same amount of time).

15 minutes before the competition time call...

“15 MINUTES PREPARATION AND SIGHTING TIME - START”

- Start stopwatch.
- **After 14½ minutes call...**

“30 SECONDS”

- **After 15 minutes call...**

“END OF PREPARATION AND SIGHTING TIME - STOP”

Allow time for the targets to be switched from sighters to match by control room staff – (about 30 seconds). Once targets are reset

- Reset stopwatch.
- **Call**

“MATCH FIRING.....START”

After 80 minutes call...

“TEN MINUTES”

After 85 minutes call...

“FIVE MINUTES”

After 90 minutes call...

“STOP – UNLOAD”

- Clear all pistols for casing and removal
- Complete Range Report, and forward to Classification Office



Course of Fire

- Competitors are allowed to occupy their bay 15 minutes before the start of preparation time.
- Preparation & Sighting time is 15 minutes
- Competition series: 60shots in 90 minutes

Malfunctions and Repairs:

A competitor may repair or replace the pistol (if the malfunction is allowable) but no extra time is given. Extra sighters may be allowed if requested. (Rule 6.13)

***NOTE**

If the 15 minutes 'set up' prior to preparation time is varied it must be varied by the same amount for ALL details.
