PISTOL AUSTRALIA HOLSTER ACCREDITATION

Expired Pistol Australia holster accreditation causes problems for the organisers of PSQ sanctioned events and/or club competitions requiring the use of a holster. PSQ's Holster Accreditation Coordinator, Ted Collins, sends out reminders to members but this reminder is not always followed up by the member. To assist members to keep their Holster Accreditation current the PSQ Board advises the following:

- Clubs which are conducting holster events at their PSQ sanctioned Opens are asked to include a space for the entrant to include the expiry date of his/her holster accreditation on the entry form.
- In the instance of a member arriving at a competition with an expired holster card the following will need to be in place for him/her to compete at that event:
 - 3. The competitor will need to provide a dated copy of his/her renewal paperwork sent to the PSQ Holster Coordinator prior to arriving to compete; and
 - 4. The competitor will need to produce his/her previous (now expired) holster card.

If these documents cannot be produced, the competitor is unable to participate in any holster event at that time. ... all to do with the match rules; risk management and insurance cover
