### **BE PREPARED!**

Remember to have your Category H licence ready to provide to the Range Officer every time you participate .. this is a requirement of the Weapons Act whether you are on your home range or at another club.

### Pistol Australia Holster Accreditation

### Remember:

The Pistol Australia holster events of Service Pistol; WA1500 and Action Pistol require Pistol Australia holster accreditation if the match is to be conducted according to the Rules of our sport.

A 'Club' Holster accreditation or holster accreditation from another shooting organisation does not enable individuals to shoot the PA holster events according to the Rules of the match, or the sport.

# THINGS TO KNOW WHEN CONDUCTING MATCHES AT YOUR CLUB

- Every match listed on the Club's Range Approval must be a match registered to a recognised shooting organisation (advice from Weapons Licensing).
- To maintain a high level of risk management matches should be conducted as close to the rules as possible... as in any sport.
- Affiliation requirements by the recognised shooting organisations, should be adhered to, valued and followed.
- Club members participating in Pistol Australia events are required to be PA affiliated members ... a requirement of the national body for the sport of Pistol Shooting.

Help PSQ and your Club support our sport & maintain the integrity of our sport by following the above at your club.

#### THE WEAPONS ACT

A major responsibility for all of us is to ensure that the Qld Weapons Act is followed.

Two important Weapons Act musts for clubs are:

### **Participation Records:** Section 134: (to quote)

- (4) The licensee must enter the prescribed information immediately after the licensee's participation in a club organised shoot has ended.
- (5) The licensee must have the entry endorsed, in the way prescribed under a regulation, as correct by a range officer of the approved pistol club conducting the club organised shoot on the day of the shoot before the shoot ends.

**PSQ Summary:** The Act states Participation Records are to be signed off <u>after</u> the participant has completed the shoot/match, before the day's shooting ends.

### **Supervision of Unlicensed persons:** Section 53: (to quote)

- (5) The range officer must ensure the person is supervised by the range officer or another range officer at all times when the person is in physical possession of the weapon.
- (6) For subsection (5), if the person is in physical possession of a **category H** weapon, the supervision of the person by a range officer must be direct, personal and exclusive supervision by the range officer at all times when that person is in physical possession of the weapon.

PSQ cannot emphasise enough the importance of one-on-one supervision for unlicensed persons in possession of a pistol: apart from being required by the Act it is a high level of risk management for everyone concerned.

### **VARIATIONS TO THE MATCH RULES**

Back in 2013, PSQ, Weapons Licensing and our insurers, endorsed some 'allowable variations' for those members who had injuries; physical conditions or medical issues which made it difficult for them to shoot the matches according to the rules: mostly related to shooting position/s and shooting two-handed in a match which specified one-handed shooting: This endorsement was applicable to <u>Club level</u> competition only.

Club Committees which had members who needed to participate in a way which varied from the rules were advised to officially endorse this variance and record this via a spreadsheet or simple list, denoting the member's name and condition supported by a medical statement from the member's doctor.

All to ensure that, in the event of an incident on the range, the club was aware of the specific circumstances of that member.

These variations are not related to those members who are officially classified as having a disability: are wheelies or amputees or have a condition which puts them into the 'disability' category .....allowing these members to compete at Sanctioned Event level.

As Clubs were advised back in 2013, these variations do not apply to PSQ sanctioned events, and this policy has not changed.

That PSQ document, in part, relevant to physical variations, stated:

### **Acceptable Variations:**

- a) using two hands instead of one
- b) sitting, instead of stated match positionsbut only if:

there are acceptable extenuating circumstances such as:

- age of shooter (minor or elderly)
- medical condition
- inexperience of shooter

All the above are for safety reasons.

These variations were endorsed in consultation with WL and our insurers to allow members with physical problems to continue their participation in the sport, and to assist them in maintaining their participation requirements.

To quote the 2013 document, and to advise that the statement below has not changed:

These variations are acceptable only for <u>Club level competition</u> – all Sanctioned Open Shoots, Regional Championships, Regional, Games, Masters Games, State, National and International events must be conducted according to the Rules for the events.

\* Remember the ISSF Supported Rest Match is an official match to help support older members: add it to your Range Approval!
