### **Expiry of PSQ Membership**

Membership with PSQ and Pistol Australia is only current whilst a member is a current financial member of a PSQ Member Club.

Good work by all the clubs which are registering their new members with us as soon as they join their club – this ensures insurance cover & is great risk management by the club.

#### **HOLSTER CARD EXPIRY**

Holster accreditation renewal is due before the expiry date: 30 days after the expiry date is the period allowable for a late renewal.

After 30 days past the expiry date PSQ insurance cover is not in place whilst participating in a holster match.

Members are not eligible to compete in a PSQ /Pistol Australia sanctioned event unless they have holster accreditation which is **current**; that is, within the period of their accreditation.

The 30 days 'grace' period only applies to insurance cover, not to the eligibility to compete in a sanctioned event.

To maintain this accreditation a member must show participation records confirming participation in at least 6 Pistol Australia Holster events.

### From Margaret Baker Chief Range Officer PSQ State ISSF Championships 2019

I would like to personally thank the competitors who willingly lent a hand on the ranges over the weekend of the ISSF State Championships. We had Level 1 and Level 2 RO's, and judges who were competing and some who have yet to become officials, all helping when asked. A big thank you to Nicola, Greg and Greg, Andrew, David, Jim, Kevin and others that I have might have missed .... sorry.

We are all becoming much more comfortable with the electronic target system but when there are 30 plus shooting 25m Standard Pistol, 40 plus on the 10m range and almost 50 shooting 50m Pistol, you do need a number of pairs of eyes watching out for malfunctions, competitors having problems of a various nature and cross fires.

Now we have the "Shaw system" happening on the 25m range, you don't have to be a Level 2 RO to operate the system! But a Level 1 or 2 qualification is an advantage as a range officer on the floor. Come along and try it out!

I hope that you all enjoyed the finals?

This is another area where we are all gaining confidence: there were four finals and for each a different person was the Chief Range Officer. What a fantastic job our two announcers did - thanks Chris and Nicki.

We also had some great workers in Equipment Control: thank you to Larry; Monica and John.

Over the next six months there will be a number of small competitions at the Brisbane International Shooting Centre - why not come along and try shooting on the electronic targets and find out how you might be able to help at the 2020 PA Nationals over Easter?
