To assist in the future development of juniors competing at Pistol Australia National Championships and best practice principles of participating at competitions of all levels, both domestically and internationally, it has been decided for Juniors to compete in both the Junior and Senior matches that they will only shoot the match once, with the option to have the score count towards both categories providing pre nomination within the entry form.

Changes to conditions for juniors competing in future ISSF/PA National Championships

Juniors may enter and compete in 25m Pistol Junior, 10m Air Pistol Junior Women and 10m Air Pistol Junior Men matches. This score will be used where juniors also choose to enter the equivalent senior event.

Note: only the score for Junior Women from the 25m Pistol Junior match will be recorded in the 25m Pistol Women senior match

Juniors who wish to compete in the 50m Pistol, 25m Rapid Fire, 25m Standard Pistol and 25m Centre Fire matches will enter the senior matches. This score will be used where juniors also choose to enter the equivalent junior event. Their score will be recorded in the junior results list and will be awarded the junior trophies.

Juniors will only pay the junior registration fee and match fee for all matches that they enter.

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age of 21 on December 31st in the year of the Competitions.
