THE WEAPONS ACT

A major responsibility for all members, and for Club Committees, is to ensure that the Qld Weapons Act is followed.

Repeating Advice from Jan-Feb:

Supervision of Unlicensed persons:

Section 53: (to quote)

- (5) The range officer must ensure the person is supervised by the range officer or another range officer at all times when the person is in physical possession of the weapon.
- (6) For subsection (5), if the person is in physical possession of a **category H** weapon, the supervision of the person by a range officer must be direct, personal and exclusive supervision by the range officer at all times when that person is in physical possession of the weapon.

The Range Register & Sighting of Cat H Licences:

The Act states:

97 Club must keep range use register books

- (1) It is a condition of an approved shooting club's shooting club permit that the club must keep a range use register and ensure the register is available at all times when the range is being conducted by the shooting club.
- (2) Before a person uses a range conducted by an approved shooting club to discharge a weapon, the person must—
- (a) if the person is a licensee, produce the person's licence to a range officer at the range; and
- (b) enter in the range use register the details provided for under subsection (3).

Maximum penalty—20 penalty units.

Note—

If the person proposing to use the range is not a licensee, the person must produce the identification and complete the approved form required under section 53.

- (3) The register must include provision for the following details—
- (a) the person's identity;
- (b) the category of weapon the person will use on the range;

WEAPONS ACT (continued)

- (c) other details prescribed under a regulation.
- (4) It is a condition of an approved shooting club's shooting club permit that the club ensure that a range officer of the club must inspect the entry made by the person in the register and endorse the entry as correct before allowing the person to use the range.
- (5) An endorsement under this section must clearly identify the person making the endorsement.
- (6) Subsections (2)(a) and (4) do not apply in relation to a range officer of the approved range using the range to discharge a weapon.

HOLSTER USE

Pistol shooters

competing/participating in any of the Pistol Australia holster events <u>must</u> have a Pistol Australia Holster card.

Prior to a PA holster match being shot the PA holster card should be provided to the Range Officer. Members are renewing their holster accreditation as it comes due, to allow them to continue to participate in the PA holster matches.

Our thanks to Ted Collins, PSQ's volunteer Holster Proficiency Accreditation Officer, who processes all the new accreditations and renewals.

PLAY BY THE RULES

The above heading is a term used often by Sport Australia, to cover not only 'playing the game' but in governance; member protection etc. The sport of Pistol Shooting aspires to this policy and Pistol Shooting Queensland tries to ensure that all clubs and members are aware of the of the rules so that members are aware of and adhere to the rules of our sport, no matter which discipline/s we choose.

Using the Pistol Australia Range Officer Guides can be very helpful – these guides ensure the correct match format and range commands are used, no matter which PSQ/PA club members may attend.

The Rule books for each discipline are an important part of this – ensuring the pistols and calibres and ammunition used fit within the rules of our sport.

The Level 1 Range officer Course is a great stepping stone for members to get to know the rules in a basic sense – the level 2 courses in the specific disciplines then go into much greater detail.

To ensure members are using the correct range commands refer to the current PA Range Officer Guides which can be down-loaded from the Pistol Australia website:

BEST PRACTICE IN HANDLING LEAD

The ISSF Supported Rest Match can be included in PSQ Open competitions. Brisbane International PC has included this event on their program (for 10m Air Pistol) for their 06 April BIPC Open and the Toowoomba PC is planning for this for their Open also. Clubs have been provided with the rules, but contact PSQ if you need them.

To summarise:

- 1. This match caters for 10m Air Pistol and 50m Pistol: all using a rest
- 2. 30 scoring shots
- 3. 3 categories:
 - a) Group A Senior Men & Women 56 65 years Standing
 - b) Group B Senior Men & Women 66 - 71 years Standing
 - c) Group C Senior Men & Women 72 years and over Seated (stool)

There are rules for the construction of the rest – we have information for this also.

Great for keeping our older members in our sport a little longer.
