Information for PSQ Members

COVID-19 and Sport

Pistol Clubs are required to maintain adherence to the COVID requirements for all sport.

The Tracing Register is to be maintained (either paper based or QR Code) along with physical distancing; sanitisation; hygiene and cleaning protocols.

This allows clubs and the host clubs of sanctioned events to comply with the basic COVID requirements for outdoor sport & to protect their members and visitors.

PSQ Sanctioned Events 2021

50 events have been sanctioned to date.

Clubs have provided the COVID Checklist dated 25.01.21 as the guide for PSQ sanctioned events – this is being reviewed at the moment, with the latest easing of instructions by the Govt in mind – when we receive the updated Industry Plan for Outdoor Sport from the Qld Govt. PSQ will review our COVID Checklists.

Participation Requirements 2020-2021

Participation requirements (with COVID adjustments) for members have remained as previously advised by Weapons Licensing – this advice is attached again for members' information.

PSQ Affiliation Fees 2021-22

The PSQ Fee Chart for 2020 - 21- 22 is attached.

PSQ annual affiliation for 2021-22 will be \$106.00 for an adult and \$53.00 for a junior.

The 2019 AGM set the affilation fee at \$106.00 and \$53.00 for 2020-21, but this was lowered by \$20.00 (adult) and \$10.00 (junior) due to a reduction in PA affiliation for 2020-21, which PSQ passed on to all clubs and members.

We will now return to the fee set at the 2019 AGM: all set out on the attached Fee Chart

Range Officer Courses

Clubs have RO Course requests registered with PSQ, with some already completed.

The Level 1 course is at no cost; the Level 2 course requires a deposit of \$20.00 which is refunded on completion of the Course.

We encourage members to do the Level 1 Course as a basic skill for members over 18.

This is a very basic course to give members the confidence to run a range correctly, using the Pistol Australia Range Guides.

Before doing the course members are encouraged to run ranges at their own club often to give them familiarity with the match format, the correct commands to be used and with the range equipment they may need to operate.

COACHING COURSES

There are options out there for shooters to get coaching in a specific discipline or to gain a nationally recognised Coach Accreditation through Pistol Australia and Shooting Australia.

Approach your Club Committee if you want a PSQ/PA accredited Coach to come to your Club!

All coaching is free to members.

- Attend a coaching session
- Develop a plan
- Set goals
- Start slowly & carefully to master technique
- Move through the stages of development: precision to timed fire & low calibre to higher calibre.

PISTOL AUSTRALIA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021

As everyone will know by now the PA National Championships were suspended after the third day, due to the Brisbane COVID Lockdown on 29 March.

25 Yd Service and Service Pistol UR were not completed.

Thank you to the volunteers who worked at the Metropolitan PC venue for this section of the Championships – well done, and thank you!

The ISSF part of the Nationals was suspended with many interstate and Queensland competitors departing Brisbane on the Monday afternoon.

Some competitors did stay on however, and a new event was quickly organised.

The Grand Prix was restricted to the ISSF Olympic events to ensure the range could cater for entries over the 3 days: Good

Friday; Saturday & Easter Sunday.

Entries were taken from any Nationals' competitor and they were able to participate in the qualifying match and then go on to compete in a Final (if qualifying) in their home state, via Zoom or by whatever method endorsed scores could get to us.

Media crews were on site at Belmont to cover all aspects of the PA events & the Grand Prix, including live streaming of all Finals.... provided by Pistol Australia.

Prizes were donated by Bruce Quick of Potter Firearms for all Grand Prix placegetters.

We had a wonderful crew of volunteers who stayed on to help PSQ and PA run the Grand Prix – their work on the ranges, and in maintaining the required COVID protocols was excellent and really appreciated by everyone on site.
