PSQ Update for PSQ Members

COVID-19 and Sport

Pistol Clubs are to maintain adherence to the Government's & Queensland Health's COVID requirements for all community sport.

COVID Requirements:

PSQ Sanctioned Events (and at your club level events too)

Government requirements continue to stipulate:

1. Regular cleaning and sanitising of facilities and touch points.
2. Physical distancing to occur:
 - Off the shooting line and generally around the facility.
 - On the shooting line (every second bay, if possible)
3. Competitors who are unwell are not to attend, or asked to leave if unwell.
4. Masks are no longer a requirement on or off the firing line but individuals can choose to do so of-course.

SHOOTING AUSTRALIA EVENTS @ BISC

Pistol Competitions @ BISC

The Shooting Australia pistol events held at BISC are conducted by PSQ, not a PSQ club.

Shooting Australia has asked PSQ to conduct these events for their Australian Team squad members in 2022.

However ... all PSQ members are able to participate in these competitions, either as volunteers or competitors.

These events are just like any other PSQ Sanctioned event (albeit on electronic targets) with the Olympic events of 25m Rapid Fire; 10m Air Pistol; 25m Pistol Women (& Men) and the WSPS events being the major focus.

Members are invited to come and experience the electronic targets & new Finals' formats.

Your Fees for 2021-2022

The adult affiliation for 2021-22 is \$86.00.

The Junior affiliation is \$33.00.

The above fees factor in the PA reduction for the 2021-22 year of \$20.00 per member.

Each member who was affiliated with PSQ before November 15 2021 has received a \$20.00 gift card as a \$20.00 refund of the PA affiliation fees – we were advised of the fee decrease after we had invoiced Member Clubs for the \$106.00 adult and \$53.00 Junior fees for 2021-22.

PSQ passes on \$25.70 for an adult and \$2.85 for a Junior from the \$86.00 and \$33.00 charged respectively, to PA. Pro-rata (50% off) begins on 01 May each year.

This year pro-rata will be Adult \$43.00 and Junior \$16.50: 01.05.22 – 31 Oct 2022.

RANGE OFFICER SIGNING THE RANGE REGISTER

Remember that the Range Register must show the signature of the Range Officer for each person (that is, each line) who signed the Range Register.

No brackets or dittos to be used.

Each person must provide their Category H licence for sighting at the time.... no licence, no shoot! **Make sure this is happening at your club please – this is a Weapons Act requirement**

The Cat H or Minors Licence plastic card must be provided – a photo or digital copy cannot be used instead.

The Range Register must not be signed by non-shooters.

COVID Care

With COVID still very much a concern PSQ is:

1. Following the Queensland Government's and Queensland Health's directives;
2. Committed to protecting Member Clubs; the members; the volunteers and the Judge/s we are delegating to supervise these events;
3. Allowing vaccinated and un-vaccinated members to compete at a PSQ Sanctioned event if the host club endorses this.

Individual members attending any club or PSQ sanctioned event have an individual responsibility to adhere to the COVID rules & club and/or PSQ rules in place at the time and to consider their fellow members.

One **Club Visit** has been completed to date: to the Mount Isa PC, by PSQ President Michele Sandstrom: March 12-13.

PSQ Board members are hoping to get to more clubs around the state in 2022 as the last 2 years has caused this part of PSQ services to be put to one side.
