#### PISTOL AUSTRALIA DRESS GUIDELINES FOR ALL ATHLETES, COACHES & OFFICIALS

Please refer to the attached Guidelines as received from Pistol Australia.

#### 'Purpose

In order to provide a publicly acceptable appearance for the sport of Pistol Shooting Pistol Australia has developed the following dress guidelines. This 'dress code' will be applicable to all Pistol Australia competitions, regardless of the discipline.

For ISSF events Shooting Australia has agreed to adopt each affiliates own dress code where the event has been confirmed as a Shooting Australia endorsed event.

#### Note that for the elite Shooting Australia events the ISSF Dress Code will apply.

These guidelines take into account safety, appearance and the public perception of our sport'.

Are you working towards the Level 1 Range Officer accreditation?

Make sure your club provides you with plenty of opportunities to be the Range Officer at your weekly club events so you can practice and gain confidence.

All you need to do is:

- use the Pistol Australia Range Guide for the relevant event.
- know how to use the range equipment (timer, stop watch etc).
- be aware of the paperwork to be in place before and after the competition (sighting licences; signing the range register and signing the competitors' participation record)

New Pistol Australia requirements for Pistol Australia Level 2 Range Officers and Pistol Australia Judges.

As advised earlier this year:

Each of PSQ's Level 2 RO's and Judges have been provided with a Log Book to record the details of their volunteer roles:

We are looking to have more (and younger!) members progress to the higher levels of officiating – with ISSF Judge accreditation being a priority.

The log book will assist when Level 2 RO accreditation is due for renewal.

# Changes: ISSF & Action Pistol

# Form 2 (ISSF Sanctioned Event Levels) Amendment

#### **CHANGES**

#### **Rule Changes**

#### **ISSF Rules from 01 January 2023**

These changes affect the Preparation time allowed, as shown below:

25m Standard Pistol	When	3 minutes	
25m Precision (CF;WSPS;25m Pistol)	advised by Range Officer	3 minutes	
25m Rapid Fire Stage	Officer	3 minutes

10m Air Pistol & 10m Supported Rest	10 minutes	15 minutes (Preparation and sighters)	
50m Pistol & 10m Supported Rest	10 minutes	15 minutes (preparation and sighters)	

#### **ACTION PISTOL: Change**

The Conditions of Entry for Action Pistol sanctioned events must now state that:

# Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Action Pistol Rules, effective 01 January 2023, will apply.

This must now appear on all Entry Forms for PSQ sanctioned events, along with the usual Conditions of Entry.

As stated on the Pistol Australia website under the 'Officiating ' and 'Rules' tabs, Pistol Australia Action Pistol 'is now controlled by the 'Civilian Marksmanship Program'.

Previously PA (and therefore PSQ) accreditation to access this discipline was granted by the NRA.

#### Change to the Form 2: Levels for ISSF events

As has been explained earlier this year, the past few years have seen a depletion in the number of Judges able to officiate at PSQ ISSF sanctioned events.

This led to the PSQ Board and some of our Judges working on a plan early this year which would lighten the workload for our Judges.

This plan established 3 levels of ISSF Sanctioned Events: Level 1 having a designated person (Level 2 RO) to sign off on the event, rather than a Judge.

The Board has found that Level 2 events which originally required a Judge to officiate, continued to pose a problem with regard to a Judge's attendance.

There has now been a change made: a Level 2 event can be signed off by a Judge *or* two (2) Level 2 Range Officers.

The Form 2 Levels information document, amended and endorsed by the PSQ Board on 14.02.23 is attached for your information.

Updated information on the State Squad's selection scores regarding Level 1 events is included in the new Form 2.

#### RANGE OFFICER SIGNING THE RANGE REGISTER

The Range Register must show the signature of the Range Officer for each person (that is, each line) who signed the Range Register.

#### No brackets or dittos to be used.

Each person must provide their Category H licence for sighting at the time.... no licence, no shoot! Make sure this is happening at your club please – this is a Weapons Act requirement

The Cat H or Minors Licence <u>plastic card</u> must be provided – a photo or digital copy cannot be used instead.

The Range Register must not be signed by non-shooters.

All the above was checked with Weapons Licensing when the Shooting Organisations had a joint meeting with WL on Monday 28 November 2022.

#### **Weapons Licensing** confirmation: Participants who compete in a detail must not be the Range Officer for that detail.

The Weapons Act states that the Range Officer must ensure that everyone participating is 'properly supervised'.

Risk management and adhering to the Weapons Act is then in place.
