RANGE OFFICERS IN TRAINING

Does your Club have members working towards the Level 1 Range Officer accreditation?

Make sure they have plenty of opportunities to be the Range Officer at your weekly club events so they can practise and gain confidence.

All they need to do is learn to:

- use the Target Pistol Australia Range Guide for the relevant event.
- know how to use the range equipment (timer, stop watch etc).
- be aware of the paperwork to be in place before and after the competition (RO's name on display; sighting licences; signing the range register and signing the competitors' participation record).

REMEMBER: A member does not have to be an accredited RO to run ranges at your club, according to the Weapons Act.

The Weapons Act's definition of a Range Officer is: Clause 108

(2) A range operator must ensure every person who physically possesses or uses a weapon at the approved range is properly supervised by an adult (a range officer) who—

(a) holds a firearms licence under this Act; or

(b) is a range officer, however called, under a law of another State

SIGNING THE RANGE REGISTER

CLUB DOCUMENTS ON DISPLAY FOR MEMBERS

PSQ TARGETS

AT THE CLUB: The Weapons Act and the Weapons Act Regulations

RANGE OFFICER SIGNING THE RANGE REGISTER

1. Range Register must show the signature of the Range Officer for each person (that is, each line) who signed the Range Register.
No brackets or dittos to be used.
2. Each person must provide their Category H licence card for sighting at the time.... no licence, no shoot! A **Weapons Act** requirement.
3. The Range Register must not be signed by non-shooters.

Weapons Act/Weapons Act Regulations Clarification #1

Regarding the signing of the Range Register and the various columns: Refer to the Regulations which confirm that under the 'Personal Details' section and the 'Club' column this means the **location** where this individual member is shooting on that particular day.

The Regulations state and confirm that it is the location (place) where the individual is participating, not the participant's own home club:

141 Additional details for which range use register kept by approved shooting club is to make provision For section 97(3)(c) of the Act, the following details are prescribed—

(ACT -- 97 Club must keep range use register books - (c) other details prescribed under a regulation.)

- (a) the date and **place** of each handgun shooting competition, or club organised shoot, in which the person entering the details in the range use register is to participate in at the range;

This provides the Personal Details of where this participant is competing on any given day.

MAKE SURE ... that your club has

on display for all members to see and be aware of:

1. **Weapons Licensing Club & Range Approvals**
2. **The Club's Standing Orders**

As stated by Weapons Licensing:

'Beside the match rules, the Club's Constitution; Range and Club Approvals and the Club's Standing Orders dictate how a Club operates its range'.
