		1. Competitors must be financial members of Pistol Shooting Queensland Ltd or other interstate recognised shooting body affiliated with Target Pistol Australia or meet the requirements of the Target Pistol Australia General Technical Rules Section 3, pertaining to overseas competitors.	
		2. CMP Action Pistol Shooting Rules 4 <sup>th</sup> Edition, effective 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2026, will apply.	
		3. Target Pistol Australia Holster card, affiliation card and Category H Firearm Licences (plastic cards) must be provided at registration. <b>No Cat H Licence, no shoot.</b>	
		4. Competitors' ammunition will be tested for power factor. Minimum 120 pf Maximum 140 pf	
		5. Sample loads will be collected at random totalling 6 rounds.	
		6. A limit of 3 guns per competitor over the two days will apply.	
		7. Suitable eye and ear protection and enclosed footwear are mandatory.	
	8. Equipment inspection on range, prior to commencement of competition.		
	9. Ties will be decided by shoot-off. Rule 7.5 & 7.6		
	10. Competitors to assist with range duties		
	11. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.		

	<p>12. No full-jacketed ammunition permitted.</p> <p>13. Attend briefing before competition commences: 15 minutes before start of competition</p> <p>14. Protest time:</p> <p><b>Rule: 7.8 &amp; 7.9</b></p> <p><b>Preliminary Bulletins</b> – Preliminary Bulletins on all matches will be posted promptly on the Official Bulletin Board and remain for a reasonable length of time to allow competitors to notify the Statistical Office of apparent errors. Production and Production Optics events are again being run on a trial basis to assess interest in the events for future State Champs.</li> <li>2. For a State Champion medal to be awarded in either event in 2026 there must be at least 5 entries overall for each event.</li> <li>3. Places in each grade will be awarded according to the number of entries per grade.</li> </ol>
