Gun Checks on Sunday will be at 8:30am Competition Begins at 9:00am

1. Competitors must be financial members of Pistol Shooting Queensland Ltd or other interstate recognized shooting body affiliated with Pistol Australia, or meet the requirements of the Pistol Australia General Technical Rules Section 3, pertaining to overseas competitors.
2. Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) rules 2026 (4th Edition) will apply.
3. Holster Proficiency: Target Pistol Australia Holster cards, affiliation card and Category H Firearm Licenses must be produced at registration.
4. Competitors' ammunition will be tested for power factor (min. 120).
5. Sample loads will be collected at random totaling 6 rounds.
6. Suitable eye and ear protection and enclosed footwear are mandatory.
7. Equipment inspection on range, prior to commencement of competition.
8. Ties will be decided by shoot-off. Rule 7.5 and 7.6.
9. Competitors to assist with range duties.
10. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
11. Semi Jacketed ammunition is permitted.
12. Briefing before competition commences.
13. Late entries will be accepted only if range capacity permits.
14. **Lunch on Sunday will be catered for _payment on the day_ please advise if requiring lunch.**
15. **Cold Drinks will be available for purchase. Tea and Coffee will be supplied for no charge.**
